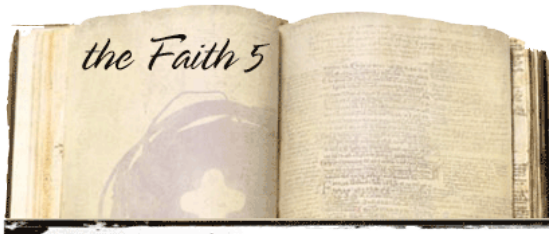
.To whom does Nehemiah turn to in the face of opposition?
