## >>READ>> Ephesians 2:10

.The word “create” in this verse is a Greek verb used only of God and denotes the creative energy he alone can exert. What good works has God uniquely created you to perform for His kingdom and His people?

>>Read the following passages in Exodus. 3: 11, 4: 1, 4: 10-13.

.In what ways can Moses’ reluctance to listen to God calling be a source of encouragement to us? (Consider the mighty acts God accomplished through Moses, despite his doubts and fears)

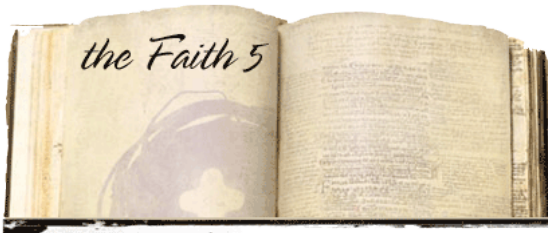
.What characteristics and gifts did God see in Moses that Moses didn’t see in himself? In what ways does this apply in your own life and spiritual journey?

.What encouragement did God provide Moses in verse 11?

.How can you relate to Moses’ reluctance to trust in God’s abilities and be obedient to His calling?

.Reflect back on Ephesians 2:20. How does knowing that you are God’s workmanship encourage you to overcome feelings of doubt and insecurity in serving Him?
