.For what purpose are spiritual gifts given? (vs. 7) What are the implications of this for you personally? Share.

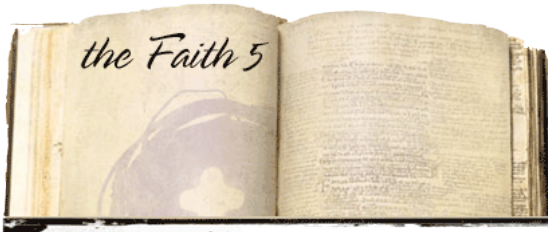
.What do you think is the difference between the Spirit's message of wisdom and message of knowledge? (vs. 8)

.Explain the difference between the faith that is given to all Christians, and the gift of faith, given to only some Christians. (vs. 9)

.Why do we sometimes place a greater value on one spiritual gift over another? What's wrong with doing this?

.What is Paul's main point in verses 8 – 11?

.Prayerfully consider the spiritual gift(s) you have been given by the Holy Spirit. In what ways has God uniquely gifted you to serve Himself and others?
