- .What is God's glory? How are the words power and glory related?
- .What are the two places that God is said to reveal His glory (Ephesians 3:21)?
- .In what ways is God's glory is shown in Jesus Christ? In what ways is God's glory is shown in the church?
- .These verses teach us that the Lord wants to express His power and glory through our lives. Think one specific place you would like to see more of Jesus' power lived out in your life for the sake of others.
