.What is the goal of all redemption? What do you think it will be like living without fear, pain or death and with the continual and direct presence of God? Share or journal.

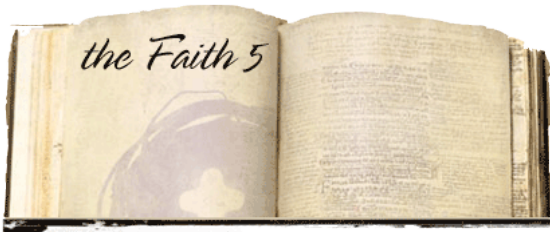
.How does the promise of eternal life make you feel? What do you imagine it will be like? What are you hoping for?
