As you read each day's passage, think about/discuss/journal:

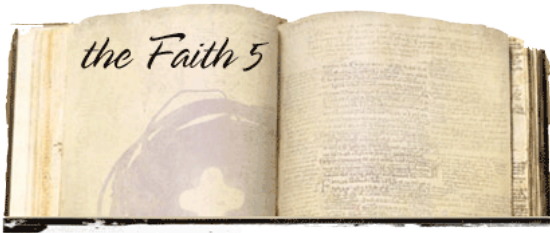
.What does this passage teach me about God? How does it inform my IDENTITY as a child of God?
