.God has designed us for work. We may not always like our jobs and at times “hate our job situations,” so how much “gladness of heart” do you presently experience in your “labor under the sun?”

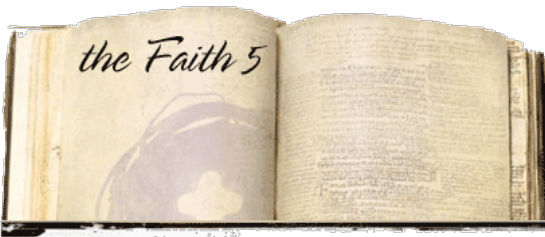
.How can you use your vocations as a mission field and an opportunity to honor God? If you looked at your job as a mission field, wouldn't it help you enjoy your work more?
